

Friday 19th February

Nanyuki Airstrip

11:00 – 5 pm Between these times ONLY you can collect your race packs. There will be NO late registration at the Start. *You must call into Nanyuki Airstrip to finalise your registration.*

Start Camp (if staying there on Friday night)

3:00 - 6:00pm Arrive before even if you have booked tents here it is advisable to get here at 6 at the latest so that you have time to sort yourselves out before it gets dark.

7:15 pm Race and spectators briefing for those camping at the Start Camp.

7:30 pm Dinner will be served at the Start Camp, for those paying the caterers direct.

Saturday 20th February

Start Camp

6:00 – 7 am Breakfast Pies will be available from Pies2Go.

7:15 am Cyclists taking part must be at the Start Camp by this time. If you are coming from Nanyuki bear in mind that it will take you at least an hour and a half to get to the start.

7:45 am Cyclists must make their way to the Start point through a crush where your numbers will be counted in. Please get to the start promptly for your briefing.

8:15 BRIEFING at the Start line.

No vehicles are to leave for the finish or spectator points at this time. They can ONLY leave after the last cyclist has passed the Campsite. The Start Camp managers will monitor vehicle movement.

8:30 am Start for all the routes including the black mambas.

9:00 am Spectators and support vehicles are free to move from the Start Camp ONLY if the Sweeping Vehicle behind the last cyclists has left.

Finish Camp

11:00 am Bar is Open! Sandwiches can be bought from Leo's & Pies from Pies2Go.

12:30 am Lunch will be served – pay in cash to any of our caterers.

2:00 pm The routes will be closed. You must board the sweeping vehicle after 2 pm!
