



BRAEBURN MINI 10to4 2019

INFORMATION SHEET

Date: Sunday 17th February 2019

Time: 7am race briefing, 7.30am race starts

Location: Borana Race Village

Cost of Entry: 2,000 (4-6 yrs) and 2,500 (6-12 yrs)

Prize Giving: Sunday 17th @ 11am (latest)

Individual and Teams Entries available.

Pre-entry only - entries or changes on the day will NOT be accepted.

- Race 1 - open to 4-6 year olds over a 2km obstacle course.
- Race 2 - open to 6-8 year olds over approx. 4.5km.
- Race 3 - open to 6-12 year olds over approx. 9km.
- Race 4 - also open to 9-12 year olds over approx. 13.5km.

TEAM ENTRIES

- If entering as a team your time will still be counted for individual ranking.
- Teams must be made up of 4 children; these can be mixed age and gender as long as they are all competing in the **same** race. An average time will be taken of all 4 competitors.
- If you want to register a team, when registering for the Mini 10to4 please select the Team option and detail your Team name and names of the 3 other team mates. If your teams are not 100% confirmed please mark names as TBC but ensure that you email your final team list to eventmanager@10to4.org before the **1st February 2019** otherwise your team won't be counted.

INTER-SCHOOL COMPETITION

- We will also be running an inter-school competition so please be specific about which school your child attends as points will be given to all competitors depending on placings and the 'winning' school awarded at Prize Giving on Sunday 17th.

HOW TO ENTER

- All registrations must be made online via the 10to4 website. The registration form can be found [here](#).
- Registration closes on the 1st February 2019, though places are limited.

FUNDRAISING

- There is no minimum fundraising target but please encourage your children to raise as much money as they can as every shilling raised goes towards Mount Kenya Trust and the valuable work they do to protect Mount Kenya and its surrounding areas and communities.
- Attached to the email is a Sponsorship form for your child to use. This form also details how sponsorship payments can be made.
- Don't forget that there is a prize for the top fundraising child, the Jasper Horword Memorial Trophy, kindly donated in memory of Jasper Horword who was a Mini 10to4 fanatic.
- And the prize for the overall top fundraiser courtesy of Tropic Air is a helicopter flight around Mount Kenya. Last year this was won by 13-year-old Tyra Behr.

CAMPING

- The 10to4 provides a unique opportunity for competitors and their families to camp on Borana Conservancy.
- Camping can be secured through the registration form on the 10to4 website.
- Camping is free for under 18s but carries a KSh.1000 charge per adult for the whole weekend (which is a bargain!).

ONSITE REGISTRATION

- Children taking part in the Mini 10to4 are able to register for their bike badge and goody bags at any stage across the event weekend.
- There is however **no** option to sign up for a race onsite. All registrations must be in ahead of the deadline on the 1st February 2019.
- Pre-race briefing is at 7am, all children must be present at this so we can sign them in for their race.

If you wish to ride with your child, please complete a separate registration form and select 'adult rider supporting mini 10to4 cyclist' and we will class you as riding 'hors concours'. Your age will give you away! Please note, if there are too many adults requesting to do this we will have to restrict numbers due to safety reasons but rest assured we will ensure that there is an adult riding behind each race as a sweeper.
